### Another piece of extraordinary freight for the Conceptum Group

Just three weeks after being awarded the project scope of ocean freight and inland transport from Spain to Port Kembla, Australia for a complete Cement Grinding Plant the vessels began loading.

The carrier invested heavily in the engineering before being awarded the ocean freight to confirm that all cargo would fit on 5 voyages based on their fleet. It was a risk and it has paid off huge dividends.

140,000 cbm of modularized, partly dis-mantled Cement Grinding plant on five 12,800 dwt MPP vessels at first appeared to be impossible but with 13 to 18 meter tall pieces on each vessel generating 18,000 to 21,500 cbm of cargo stowed just on deck for each voyage, it allowed for the impossible to become a reality.
